



Supplies Needed:

- Plastic straws
- Craft foam, wax paper (something that won't absorb water)
- Pipe cleaner
- paper
- Glue
- ruler
- hole punch

What to do:

- Cut straws; 4" pieces for the raft & 4.5" for bottom of the raft and the mast.
- Cut foam/wax paper into 3.5" squares (cut smaller than the straws for raft)
- Insert pipe cleaner into the mast straw. Poke other end of the pipe cleaner into the cut-out square. Fold the pipe cleaner around and tape to bottom of square.
- Glue the 4" straws onto the square around the mast as close together as possible.
- Turn the raft over and glue three longer straws in opposite direction of raft straws (to stabilize raft).
- Have kids write the memory verse on the sail (paper), punch a hole in the middle at the top and bottom of the sail and thread it onto the mast.
