

As your preschooler is making their artwork, remind them of how and why Jesus died on the cross for us. He paid for our sins. Things we have done that are bad. Jesus NEVER sinned, but He loves us so much that he chose to die on the cross so we would be able to know God and have a relationship with Him.



If you don't have washable paint handy, put a little dish soap in what you do have and it becomes washable.

No paint, no problem – trace your child's hands and they can color them.

Cross can be made from just about anything; paper, craft sticks even twigs from outside.



Use tape to make a cross on the paper then let your preschooler color or paint their own design.
