

Activity 1 (Younger Kids)

In this world craft

What you need: In this world Activity Page, green & blue tissue paper or construction paper, glue

- Tear tissue or construction paper into nickel size pieces.
- Show kids which parts of the world picture are green and which are blue.
- One section at a time let kids glue paper onto the world until it is covered.

*You may need to dot the glue yourself for younger kids, others you will be able to give them the glue and watch.

Activity 2

Go & Tell

What you need: Paper plate, green & blue washable paint, black marker

- Using the black marker trace the circle in the middle of a paper plate. Then, around the edge write "Tell others about Jesus" Matthew 28:19.
- Use your phone or computer to show kids a picture of the world.
- Then let kids dip their fingers into the blue & green paint (one color at a time, of course) to make their own picture of the world in the circle on the plate.

What you say:

With each of these crafts you can talk to kids about how things in this world can sometimes be hard, things may not always go exactly like we want them to, but no matter what Jesus always loves us and will be there to help us if we trust and believe in Him.

Jesus had troubles in this world too, but He defeated the world and He wants to always be there to help us. He loves us all so very much that He wants us to tell everyone we know about Him, about how much He loves them and how He died on the cross to save us all.
