

A bouquet of flowers

- ☺ You can make flower handprints by painting your hands or trace and cut out from construction paper.
- ☺ You can make her a bouquet using cut up egg cartons, paint and use button centers
- ☺ You can even make a bouquet using a fork!!
- ☺ Stems and leaves are easily painted on you can use crayons or markers or chenille wire (pipe cleaners).
- ☺ A ribbon or bow always adds a special touch if you have it and a dusting of glitter adds a great sparkle.

When making these bouquets, you can make so many different materials work.

Just have fun!! It will be loved for sure.

Cupcake Liner Flowers



- ☺ Fold cupcake liners in half, then fold in half 3 more times.
- ☺ Use scissors to round edges or you could make them pointed if you want.
- ☺ Unfold to have your flower petals.
- ☺ Put buttons, Jewels or whatever you wish for the center
- ☺ For the stem, you can use popsicle sticks, colored green, and attach leaves; you can attach to green pipe cleaners (chenille wire) paint a stem and leaves on your paper and attach flower to the top.



For a simpler version:

- ☺ Fold cupcake liner in half, from the flat side, cut a V shape out of the liner.
- ☺ Draw or paint stems and leaves.
- ☺ Leaves could also be cut out and glued or green thumbprints
- ☺ Flatten liners with the cut out on top
