

Fun Paperclip Bookmarks



WHAT YOU NEED:

- ☺ Large paper clips (I like colored ones)
- ☺ Buttons, pom-poms, jewels, ribbons, yarn even little characters
- ☺ Glue (hot glue works best, but use what you have. It just may take longer to dry.)

WHAT TO DO:

- ☺ When gluing paper clips, put decoration on the end that the prongs face. You need the two curved ends free to hold the paper.
- ☺ For pom-pom clips; simply glue the pom-pom to the end of the paper clip.
- ☺ For button or jewels glue two bac to back with the tip of the paper clip between them.



- ☺ For a ribbon clip, first cut your ribbons/yarn the desired length. I like to use 6"-8" ribbons. That way I can trim them after tied on. Keep in mind, when you cut your ribbon it will be doubled to put on the end of the clip.
- ☺ Ribbons are tied on rather than glued. Tied at the end the prongs face.

You can tie a double shoe knot (overhand knot)



You can use a slip knot (cow knot)



- ☺ Use as many ribbons or yarn as you like. These are simple, easy and fun to make & use.
