Fiery Furnace

What You Need:

Paper plate; red, orange & yellow tissue paper; glue; scissors; crayons

What You Do & Say

- Cut a circle around the image below. Cut out words below in a rectangular, box shape.
- Glue image to middle of paper plate, have kids color it. Explain that this is the furnace Shadrack, Meshack & Abednego were thrown into because they wouldn't bow down to the king's statue.
- Glue mix of tissue paper colors around the image filling the plate with fire. Explain that after the three were thrown into the fire, the king had the furnace turned up 7 times hotter than usual. Everyone was expecting Shadrack, Meshack & Abednego to die in the fire. But they didn't. God sent an angel to protect them. Shadrack, Meshack & Abednego knew their God was the only God and they were not going to bow down to anyone but him. Because they chose to what was right and honoring to God they were saved and the king and his advisors saw God save them. They saw that Shadrack, Meshack & Abednego's God was the real God.
- Say the Bottom Line aloud and have your child repeat it. Then glue the Bottom Line on top of the fire/tissue paper, either above or below the image.
